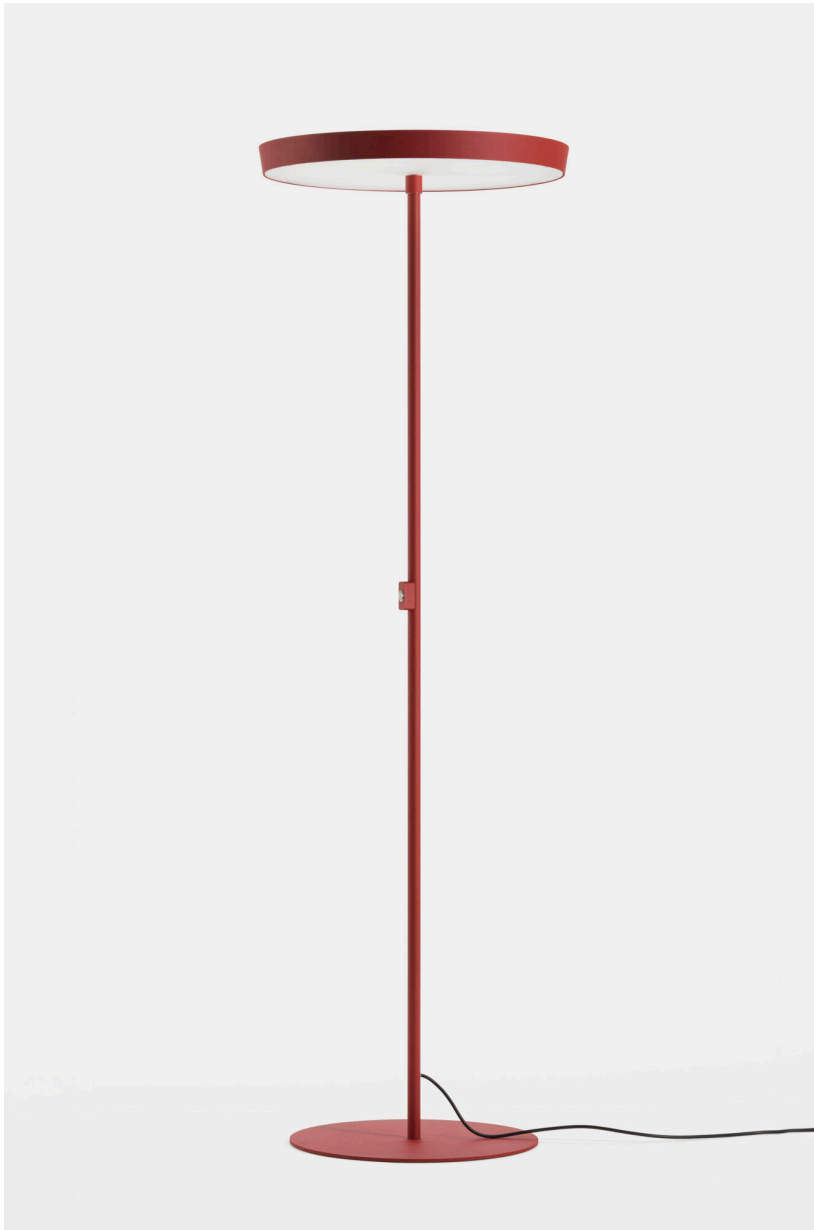

Jörg Boner's (b. 1968) *Schätti* luminaires are the flagship products of Schätti Metallwarenfabrik. A curved, powder-coated metal strip, entirely free of sharp edges, is incorporated into all the lamps in the collection and unites the myriad functional variations into one colorful harmonious family.

Jörg Boner designed the first luminaire for Glarn-based Schätti Metallwarenfabrik on the occasion of the company's anniversary in 2009. In cooperation with Boner, Schätti presented its first lighting collection in 2012. It consisted of floor and ceiling lamps with rounded sheet steel heads and a white powder coating, complemented in subsequent years by a colorful series of wall-mounted and floor lamps. All the versions of its lamps are rooted in the same formal principle, which derives from Schätti's core skills in sheet metal bending. Each lamp is set within a narrow, snug-fitting steel strip. In addition to their calm formal idiom, the hallmark of Schätti luminaires is their technical sophistication, a crucial prerequisite for use in workplaces. Motion and daylight sensors complement dimmable direct and indirect lighting as required. Thanks to the advertising material—created by Zurich graphic

design studio Norm—, as well as eye-catching presentations at trade fairs, the collection is now firmly established in the Swiss design landscape. (Sabina Tenti)
